As opposed to the quick-tach bucket models, universal fit buckets are 50% deeper. This additional space makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like for example moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing of roof trash and elevating roof gravel.
