

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriages - There are actually 4 sizes of hook type tine carriages rated by the blade carriage lifting capability. Hook type blade carriages have been the same.

The carriage bar spacing used for Class 1 is something like thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold loads up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type forks could be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted blades may vary by the amount of offset between the fork eye and the blade. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
